



# How do I view the most current version of a Permit?

This task card demonstrates how to view the most current version of a permit. It will show the entire history of the permit, including whether a permit has been revoked, suspended, is expired, or has been created as a result of a permit variation request.

## 1. Search for a Permit

Go to the BICON web homepage. Log in to your account. Select Permits. Select Search

BICON will display all active permits associated with your account

Select the Permit ID of the permit you wish to view
